**Vote No on Serpent Speech**

The serpent in the Garden of Eden used deceptive speech to tempt Eve. The supporters of this new health care tax are using deceptive speech as well. **Vote No on Tax-funded Abortions!**

The proposed new taxes would go to fund Medicaid costs. The same 2017 Legislators who say they need more money for Medicaid voted to **increase** Medicaid spending for abortions for all, including illegal aliens. So the new tax increases effectively would help pay for more abortions. Nearly half of abortions in Oregon are paid for by taxpayer money. A lot of that money comes directly from the federal government for the Medicaid programs. That means we are actually violating the Hyde Amendment which prohibits spending federal taxes for abortions. The only exceptions are for rape, incest, and when the life of the mother is threatened.

**Vote No on Corruption and Mismanagement!**

The roughly 1 billion dollars in proposed new taxes would be spent by the Oregon Health Authority. That same agency is in the midst of a huge scandal. A recent government audit shows they misspent hundreds of millions of dollars and also made payments to some 50,000 people who, as it turns out, are ineligible. Worse, officials from OHA deliberately promoted fake news, deceitful and harmful information about FamilyCare, a health services provider. We hope the State of Oregon will clean up the mess in 2018. But until we see demonstrated faithfulness on the part of OHA, we should vote No on giving them more money to misspend.
